Work on specific questions needed on survey. Survey expenses will be paid by the Town of Day. Estimate is \$3,000. Dave Davidson will work on system for tabulating surveys. As a basis for starting this work, Richard Lamb provided sample questionnaires from Minerva and Horicon.

Need update on On-Site Sewer Systems from Code Enforcement Officer Metzler. Need highway plans and issues from Highway Superintendent York – dirt roads. Obtain information from Saratoga County on county owned land on Sand Creek Road and boat launch site (DEC) and Saratoga County Park.
