

## REGULAR MEETING - April 12, 2004 – DAY TOWN BOARD

A Regular meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Day, New York was held in the Town Hall on April 12, 2004, at 7:00 P.M.

### COMMITTEE REPORTS

**CDBG Grant** - the construction of the final CDBG project is almost complete. The remaining money must be spent by July 1, 2004.

**Zoning Review Committee** - Chairman David Cox announced that the Zoning Review Committee will meet April 15<sup>th</sup>, 2004. The Committee has also asked the APA and Saratoga County for help with the GIS overlay of the Critical Environmental Areas.

**MWRRP** - a meeting is set for April 14<sup>th</sup>, 2004 with Highway Superintendent Danny Allen, Supervisor Mary Ann Johnson and Duane Nealon.

## **OLD BUSINESS**

**County Route 10 Speed Limit Change** - Town Clerk Suzanne Denn received a copy of a letter sent to Public Works Commissioner Joseph Ritchey from NYS DOT outlining the change in the Speed Limit on CR 10 in the Town of Day from 55 MPH to 45MPH.

**Johnson's Auto Crushers Contract** - signed and on file.

**Review Legislative Grant for \$17,500** - Cemetery Maps \$1,000. Town Wide Clean Up - \$7,500.00 - pick up dates to be determined. Build Gazebo and wire for lights and concerts. \$9,000.00. County Environmental Study removed from list due to the uncertainty of Saratoga County's intentions for this property.

**Resolution #2004-10** offered by Neil Allen, seconded by Cheryl to **adopt Local Law 2004-02** Pertaining to a Moratorium on Certain Approvals of Land Use Applications for a period March 17, 2004 to September 17, 2004, with the option of another six month extension for APA approval. **Classification of Refuse/Recycling Person** - reclassify from temporary to part-time. The pay is \$9.68 for Temporary and will be increased to \$9.97 for Part-time Classification.

**Personnel Manuals** - were distributed. The Town Clerk will e-mail a copy to the Town Attorney.

**Open Burning Permits for Town Residents** - will be available at the Town Hall shortly.

## **NEW BUSINESS**

Justice Krom has requested **Asst. County District Attorney Dan Kopeck** to hold a Public Meeting at Day Town Hall to explain the function of the Court System. Justice Krom will set a date and time and notify the Town Board.

**Plowing Bill submitted by Resident** -. A resident presented the Town Board with a bill for snow plowing. Supervisor Johnson and Highway Superintendent Danny Allen were not informed that there were any problems with snow removal. The Town Board feels that this is not a legitimate bill. Supervisor Johnson will write a letter to the resident informing him that the bill for Snow Removal will not be paid by the Town.
