

SPECIAL MEETING - JUNE 23, 2008 - DAY TOWN BOARD

A SPECIAL MEETING of the Town Board of the Town of Day, New York was held in the Town Hall on June 23, 2008.

The meeting was called to order by Supervisor Mary Ann Johnson at 4:56 PM and the following answered roll call: Town Council - Preston Allen, Suzanne Denn, Charlie Dreyer & Neil Allen.

Resolution #2008 - 28 made by Charlie Dreyer, seconded by Suzanne Denn, to **add June Dixon and Larry DeRubbo to the Comprehensive Plan Committee.**

Motion made by Suzanne Denn, seconded by Neil Allen, **approving Town Attorney David Avigdor**, to work on a lawsuit that has been brought against the Town regarding property on North Shore Road that was sold by the County at a tax sale auction at a rate of \$125.00 per hour.

The first candidate to be interviewed by the Town Board for the position of Part-Time Zoning Enforcement Officer was Mr. Mitchel Johnson who resides at 2476 South Shore Road in the Town of Day. Mr. Johnson had submitted a resume to the Town Board prior to the meeting for their review listing his employment history and training etc. The following people were also interviewed for this position and all had submitted letters of interest and/or resumes for the Town Board to review prior to their interviews.

Mr. Richard Lebowich, 14 Lark Street, Greenwich NY (also has a summer residence in the Town of Day), Mr. Philip Gargan, 303 Locust Grove Road, Greenfield Center, NY 12833, Mr. David Edwards, 186 Norboro Road, Gloversville NY, 12078.

Mr. Herbert Schmick, 949 County Rte 10, Corinth NY, 12822 also sent in a letter of interest and a resume but was unable to appear for an interview at this time.

Supervisor Johnson explained to each candidate at the beginning of their interview what the job entailed, the hourly salary (which in the 2008 budget is \$16.50 per hour) that there would be additional training classes (which the Town would pay for), the approximate number of hours that the job may take each week, that they may be required to appear in court to testify on the Town's behalf if necessary, that they would be working under the Code Enforcement Officer who would help whomever was selected become familiar with the Town and all of their duties, etc.

Each candidate indicated that they understood the requirements and that they did not have a problem driving to the Town of Day to perform their duties should they be hired for the position.

Motion made by Suzanne Denn, seconded by Preston Allen, to **set the date for the Public Hearing on pending local law #2008-02 Providing for the Administration and Enforcement of the New York State Uniform Fire Prevention and Building Code**, to be held on July 14, 2008 at 6:30 PM.
