TOWN OF DAY

LAW 99-2 PARKING ON TOWN ROADS

BE IT ENACTED BY THE TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN OF DAY,

<u>Section 1 - Definitions.</u> The words and phrases used in this local law shall, for the purposes of this chapter, have the meanings respectively ascribed to them by Article I of the Vehicle and Traffic Law of the State of New York.

<u>Section 2 - No Parking.</u> No person shall park or stand or cause to be parked or stand any vehicle on any town road in the Town of Day, so as to impede removal of snow or ice during or after snow or ice accumulation, except in case of an emergency or when directed to do so by a police officer.

Section 3 - Violations. Any person found guilty of violating any of the provisions of this local law shall be guilty of a violation and shall be subject to a fine not to exceed Two Hundred Fifty (\$250.00) Dollars.

B. Any vehicle parked in violation of this Local law may be removed by the Town to a safe location and stored until retrieved by the owner of the vehicle. Said towing and storage shall be at the expense of the owner of the vehicle, and shall be paid by the owner prior to retrieval of the vehicle.

This local law shall be effective immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State.
