LOCAL LAW PERTAINING TO BOATING

As revised May 21, 1997

1. **Enactment of Local Law.** This Local Law is enacted by the Town Board of the Town of Day pursuant to Town Law Section 130(17), and shall be effective immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State.

2. **Scope of Law.** This Local Law shall apply to all of Great Sacandaga Lake located in the Town of Day, except such areas that are more than 1,500 feet from shore.

3. **Speed Limit; Manner of Operation.**

A. **Safe and Prudent Speed.** Every person operating a boat shall at all times operate same in a careful and prudent manner and at a rate of speed so as to not interfere with the free and proper use of the waters or unreasonably endanger any person or property.

B. **Forty-Five Mile Per Hour Limit.** Except where a situation exists that requires a lower speed for compliance with Subsection A of this Section, and except as otherwise provided in this Local Law, the maximum speed in the waters covered by this Local Law shall be 45 miles per hour.

C. **Five Mile Per Hour Limit.** The maximum speed in the waters described in this Subsection C shall be five miles per hour. The waters to which this Subsection C applies are as follows:

1. **Paul River Bay.** The waters of Paul River Bay, which shall mean the waters of Great Sacandaga Lake which are North of a line running between the northernmost point of tax parcel number 31.16-1-58 and the northernmost point of tax parcel number 31.15-1-5.

2. **East End.** The waters of Great Sacandaga Lake which are less than 1800 feet from the Town Line between the Town of Day and the Town of Hadley.

3. **Near Bathing Areas.** Waters within 100 feet of any bathing area, swimming float, lifelines, public beach or semipublic beach.

4. **Sanitation.** The dumping of oil, refuse, garbage, sewage or waste is prohibited. Sanitary equipment must meet applicable standards established by state and federal agencies, as same may be amended from time to time.

5. **Violations.** Violations of this Local Law shall be punishable by a fine not to exceed Five Hundred (\$500.00) Dollars, or fifteen days incarceration in the county jail, or both. The penalties set forth herein shall be in addition to any penalties for violation of applicable federal, state or county laws.
